MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

Indian Industries Association

AND

Sharda University



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called MOU) made and entered on this 4th day of August 2017 between Indian Industries Association (hereinafter called IIA) with its registered office at IIA Bhawan, Vibhuti Khand, Phase-II, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow, India and Sharda University, with its registered office at Plot No-32-34, Knowledge Park-III, Greater Noida (Uttar Pradesh) 201306.

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

The objectives of this MOU are:

- To promote interaction between IIA and Sharda University in mutually beneficial areas of upcoming technologies identified and consented to by both parties.
- To provide a formal basis for joint collaborative work environment between Indian Industries Association and Sharda University.
- To become most preferred and trusted partner in the area of knowledge enrichment of students, faculty and IIA Promoters / employees with a view of sourcing talent.
- To facilitate work from Sharda University students/facilities and vice versa, on projects identified for collaborative business based on the terms and conditions as may be separately agreed upon for each of those identified projects.
- To conceptualize research projects to be executed in collaboration on need basis.

- f. To collaborate, share information and technology to develop the required skills and to this intent, parties intend to create a center of excellence to support this collaborative effort.
- g. To work towards establishing an amicable, collaborative partnership to enhance quality assurance in their respective jurisdictions
- h. To support the improvement of the quality of higher education in India.

2. STATEMENT OF INTENT & SCOPE OF MOU

2.1 Both Parties agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity:

- 2.1.1 Help develop Faculty and researchers
- 2.1.2 Developing prototypes, live projects and research projects for mutual benefit
- 2.1.3 Conducting lectures and organising symposia
- 2.1.4 Help build academic information and materials
- 2.1.5 Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest
- 2.1.6 Promoting other academic co-operation as mutually agreed

2.2 The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MOU will be planned by the Schools/Departments that carry out the specific projects. Both parties agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the land.

2.3 It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the end of concerned Party.

2.4 The Parties have agreed on the following to enhance industry-academia partnership:

- a) To improve their subject knowledge and awareness from third year onwards, IIA may consider engaging few of them on their technology environment, if possible. Possibility of setting up a prototype version of this environment at **mutually convenient location** will be explored.
- b) IIA may at its discretion, invite students who have gone through skills enhancement workshops as part of lab, to participate in it's in Campus / off campus placement drive as per defined guidelines and criteria's.
- c) Both the parties will make efforts to organize Technology Conclave to promote thought leadership in the areas of Emerging technologies, Innovative solutions and Management issues

2.5 Initiating any other Activity with mutual consent for conducting **ZED Awareness Programs**

as per MSME / QCI guidelines

3. AREAS OF COLLABORATION

The principal technical and research areas of collaboration between IIA and Sharda University are around contemporary Manufacturing Technology areas with specific emphasis on Latest Quality methods for improvement and creating Make in India image set

4. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

IIA and Sharda University propose the following primary activities to collaborate:

3. IIA will facilitate industry visits of up to 60 students every term to their Members Factory/ Administrative Offices at Noida / Greater Noida/ Ghaziabad / Hapur and other locations in UP

4.3 Workshops, Conclave, Seminars and Events

IIA and Sharda University associates will jointly arrange or participate in Workshops, Conclaves, Seminars, Competitions and other events at state, national and international level around the area of collaboration. These Conferences are in Line with QCI/ MSME guidelines.

4.4 Special Concession to IIA Members

Sharda University is pleased to extend Special Concession to the **employees / nominees** of Members of the IIA during Admission as per **Annexure – 1** upon producing IIA Membership Card. In addition Management is pleased to give additional 5% scholarship on Tuition Fee in all the courses (except Medical Dental and Architecture)

A few candidates from Weaker sections be considered for fee waiver at the discretion of Sharda University.

Also extend Special benefit to IIA Members and its **Employees and their Families** from Sharda Hospital as per the **Annexure -2** upon producing IIA Membership card.

4.5 IIA Specific Programs:

Sharda University and IIA will explore offering IIA specific programs for B.Tech/M.Tech. students as co- branded programs.

5. PROPOSED TIMEFRAME

This MOU will come in force from the date of signing and will remain valid initially for a period of 3 years. The MOU may be renewed with mutual consent.

6. IPR

Each party reserves and retains all right, title and interest in and to its proprietary software, products, and processes. The treatment of intellectual property and data rights, including patents, industrial design registration, copyrights and all other proprietary information (including innovations not patented, designs not registered etc.) which result from the research collaboration is property of both parties. Neither party shall take any action inconsistent with, nor that might adversely affect, other party's rights hereunder. Nothing contained in this MOU will be construed as granting or conferring any rights by license or otherwise, express or implied, or otherwise for any patents, copyrights, trademarks, know-how or other proprietary rights of either party acquired prior to or after the date of this MOU.

It is also mutually agreed between the parties that this MOU excludes development/creation or invention of IPR by students, faculty, and employees of either party, who has received a grant from any university, government or any other funding organization. In other words, IPRs developed by virtue of joint work done by IIA and Sharda University stakeholders under this MOU will be "Joint Intellectual Property" of IIA and Sharda University only.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. During the period of this MOU each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- b. The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information:
 - is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
 - is already known or become known to the receiving party
 - is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party,
 - is independently developed by the receiving party; or
 - is required to be disclosed by law or court order.

Parties acknowledge that the confidential information is valuable and unique. In case of breach, the affected party shall be entitled to injunctive relief in addition to all other remedies available in law or equity including monetary damages.

In addition to above, the stakeholders involved during this program engagement should adhere to security policies including information security of both parties. Researchers and developers must comply to information security policies.

8. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other MOUs or collaborations of any kind.

9. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written consent of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 90 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any Research MOU. Neither party is entitled to any compensation in the event of termination of this MOU

11. ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this MOU, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

12. COSTS OF THE MOU

Each Party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU.

13. Neither party shall be liable for damages for any delay or failure to perform its obligations hereunder, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party or without it's fault or negligence, including without limitation, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earthquakes, explosions, acts

of god or state or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of any governmental body.

14. During the term of this MOU, and immediately following the termination of this MOU, neither IIA nor Sharda University shall knowingly make an offer of employment to any officer, partner or employee of the other who is involved with the efforts under this MOU, without prior written approval of the other party.
15. This MOU is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint venture, partnership, or formal business organization of any kind, and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be only those expressly set forth herein.
16. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to grant either party the right to make commitments of any kind for or on behalf of the other without the other's prior written consent. At all times contemplated herein, IIA and Sharda University shall remain independent contractors, each responsible for its own employees. Each party assumes no responsibility to the other for costs, expenses, risks, and liabilities arising from the efforts of the other.
17. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this MOU, any exhibit or attachment or any other document signed between the Parties regarding the subject matter of this MOU, either prior or subsequent to this MOU, in no event shall either Party be liable for any loss of profits or revenue, or loss or inaccuracy of data or for any direct, indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages incurred by the other Party.
18. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this MOU, any exhibit or attachment or any other document signed between the parties regarding the subject matter of this MOU prior to this MOU, in no event shall either party be liable to the other for the non-fulfillment or non-performance by either party of its intentions laid down herein and neither party shall be liable to the other party for any loss of profits or revenue, or loss or inaccuracy of data or for any direct, indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages incurred by the other party as a result of such non-fulfillment or non-performance.
19. This MOU shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of India. Any and all disputes pertaining to this MOU shall be referred to the Courts at Noida, which shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute.


20. SIGNED IN DUPLICATE

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the MOU and having equal legal validity.


