



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs

And

This Memorandum of Understanding ('MoU') is entered into 13th October 2011, by and between Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs ("COWE") and Indian Industries Association

Preamble

Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs ("COWE") and Indian Industries Association recognize the common interest of both organizations to cooperatively pursue activities that build economic parity and enhance business opportunities for small and micro enterprises.

Therefore, in recognition of this mutually beneficial relationship Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs ("COWE") and Indian Industries Association agree to enter into an MoU to work together to:

- a) Jointly collaborate on topics of common interest
- b) Leverage their respective and collective capabilities for the benefit of those served

Proposed Cooperative Activities

Specific cooperative activities may include, but will not be limited to the following:

- 1. Networking opportunities to facilitate business growth.
- 2. Sharing of concerns of micro and small enterprises, and synergizing and cooperating to overcome the limitations.
- 3. Identification of national and international business opportunities and alliances for the benefit of both parties including the opportunity to meet with multinational corporations that could be buyers.

- 4. Delivery of educational and skill development opportunities between the members of both parties and their respective organizations.
- 5. Exchange of information and best practices regarding strategic initiatives of each organization with periodic updates

Miscellaneous

Signature on this MoU does not constitute a financial obligation on the part of Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs ("COWE") and Indian Industries Association and nothing herein is intended to make the parties legal partners, joint venturers, or affiliates.

This MoU represents the good faith intention of the parties to collaborate as supporting organizations. The parties acknowledge and agree that nothing contained herein is intended to constitute a legally binding obligation.

This MoU will expire in two years, Either party, with or without cause, can terminate this MoU at any time with written notice.

Any modification to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
